## Nursery Staff Training (Improving Today for a Better Tomorrow)

The nursery reopening support program is a set of professional development training modules delivered through a series of online workshops, by local experts and specialists, to improve skills of workers of the early childhood sector, including managers/principles, teachers and teaching assistants. The program focuses on:

- Child Development and Quality Improvement

1	Who are the program partners?	This program is developed by the Abu Dhabi Early Childhood Authority in partnership with: 1- Ministry of Education 2- Department of Education and Knowledge 3- Sharjah Education Council 4- Abu Dhabi Public Health Center
2	What are the program goals?	1- Ensure that children's health and safety in the nursery. 2- Qualify nursery staff, build their capabilities and develop their skills 3- Ensure nursery readiness to receive children in the current circumstances 4- Identify weaknesses and turn them into strengths 5- Introduce the best childcare practices and ensure their implementation 6- Elevate nurseries' educational and developmental role
3	How many sessions are offered based on the programs?	<b>12 training sessions</b> - Program B: Optional: It consists of 12 workshops for nursery workers, and teachers in particular (these workshops will be repeated to cover the targeted number of practitioners at the UAE level according to a flexible schedule)
4	What is the number of trainees who can attend each session?	1000 trainees
5	Will the trainees be able to book or schedule their sessions?	Once the attendees complete the registration process, they will be redirected to a booking page to book the date/timing of their sessions

7	Is there a registration fee?	This program is provided free of charge by Abu Dhabi Early Childhood Authority, stemming from its role in fostering partners' capabilities to support holistic development and wellbeing of children, as well as ensuring the alignment of roles between all entities.
8	How many practitioners, (nursery workers) will benefit from the program?	More than 17,000 practitioners working in nurseries across the country

1	What is Child Development and Quality Improvement Program?	It is a training program that aims at improving practitioner knowledge of child development and wellbeing to ensure improved understanding of four aspect: Health and Nutrition, Child Protection, Family Support, and Education and Early Care. It features a set of professional development training modules delivered through a series of online workshops, by local experts and specialists.
2	Who are the beneficiaries of the program?	All nursery staff dealing with children, ages 0-8 years.
3	Is the program mandatory for all early childhood workers?	This program is not mandatory, however attending its sessions will help you cover the 30-hour training, which is required by the Ministry of Education, Department of Education and Knowledge and Sharjah Education Council.
4	What is the duration of each session?	One hour for each session
5	What are the required steps to complete the training program?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1- Register Online and Book suitable Sessions</li> <li>2- Attend Training Sessions</li> <li>3- Complete Online Assessment Successfully</li> <li>4- Obtain an Accredited Certification</li> </ul>
6	Will the trainee be awarded accredited certificates?	Attendees will receive an accredited CPD certificate and a CACHE endorsed certificate on completion of the program and assessment.
7	When to register for the program?	Registration begins on 07/March/2021
8	When will the training program begin?	The training program will begin on Saturday, 20/March/2021.
